FAQ RRC Indoor Court Sales

- **Indoor Season: Thursday November 1, 2018 - Thursday March 28, 2019**
- All timeslots are for 90 minutes.
- Total number of indoor courts: 8 clay and 2 hard
- Total number of indoor weeks: 21 in most cases (Monday and Tuesday, 19 weeks)

2018-2019 Seasonal Indoor Rates for Members **See Season Court Time Application**

Lottery Process & Rules:

- 1) Beginning on Monday, August 6th continuing through Tuesday, August 21st, sign up by submitting the application to the front desk.
- 2) Your name will then be placed by the club on the poster under Bubble or Courthouse in as many time slots as you feel you need to ensure that your tennis group gets a time for play.
 - a. **You may only sign up for the number of courts needed at a certain time for your group.**
 - i. **Example: Your group needs two courts for play and you want to play at 6:00pm on Mondays. Your group only sign up for two courts at 6:00pm on Monday in the Lottery.** If your preferred time for the season is in a high demand time slot, you may want to sign up for one or two alternate times (please prioritize your preferred time slots).
 - ii. **No overbooking is allowed by a unique group at a given day and time**
- 3) **The deadline for signups will be Tuesday, August 21st at 12:00 Noon.**
 - a. **Choices cannot and will not be added after this time or during the actual lottery.** This is to insure fairness from start to finish of the lottery process.
- 4) **You must attend the lottery if there are 5 or more names desiring to purchase a specific timeslot.**
 - a. If your timeslot has 4 or less courts requested, you **do not** need to attend, unless you have other times that will be selected in the lottery.

- b. Everyone should check the sign-ups on Wednesday August 22nd, to see if they need to be present for the lottery on Thursday evening.
- 5) The lottery process will begin with over-booked time slots in the building showing the highest number of over-subscribers for a given time period. That time will be “lotteried” first, and then the other building site will follow, to be continued with the next highest-demand time slot.
 - a. Should the same number of people sign up for the Bubble and Courthouse, the Bubble will be called first.
 - b. This system may result in your alternate time coming up for selection before your preferred time; this is a consequence which must be accepted as a risk of the process.
- 6) At the lottery, should you win your preferred or back-up time, you may ask to have your name removed from other timeslots **NOT YET SELECTED BY LOTTERY**.
 - a. As for your winning time, your name will be entered in ink on the master sheet and you are responsible for full payment for that time period. Billing for indoor time will occur on or before August 31st and will be due no later than due date of your September 2nd bill (September 30.)
 - b. **Any times not paid for in full by the due date will revert to open and available indoor time.**
- 7) All players in a Lottery Court must be Full RRC members
- 8) All players must scan/check in at the Front Desk **before play begins**.
- 9) Non RRC members are only allowed to substitute 4 times during a 12-month period.
 - a. They will also be required to pay a \$10.00 Guest Fee at each appearance.
- 10) We do not allow non-members to play for a full indoor season on Lottery courts.
- 11) If you have non-member friends that you believe would be interested in playing, please speak with Dana Schneiders about membership options.
- 12) New in 2018 RRC will split charges of any season court if requested.**

Club Programming:

- 1) The club will block courts not open for sale on certain days and times to accommodate adult clinics, junior clinics, adult leagues, and special events.
- 2) The Club reserves courts for club sponsored programs all of which are opened to members of RRC on a first come first serve basis. Non-members can participate in club programming on a one-time only basis and after members have had a chance to register.

Finally, please bear in mind that the club has a financial obligation to market our indoor courts to the fullest extent possible. This means the larger potential blocks of time are offered for sale first, following in succession by each potentially smaller category of usage. Below is the order of priority in which courts will be offered for sale:

- 1) Seasonal Sales to Full RRC Members starts August 6 for the lottery.
- 2) Additional Seasonal Sales to Full & Social Members (Starting August 24th)
- 3) Additional bookings for clinics, leagues play, private lessons, etc
- 4) Mini-packs and daily court sales
